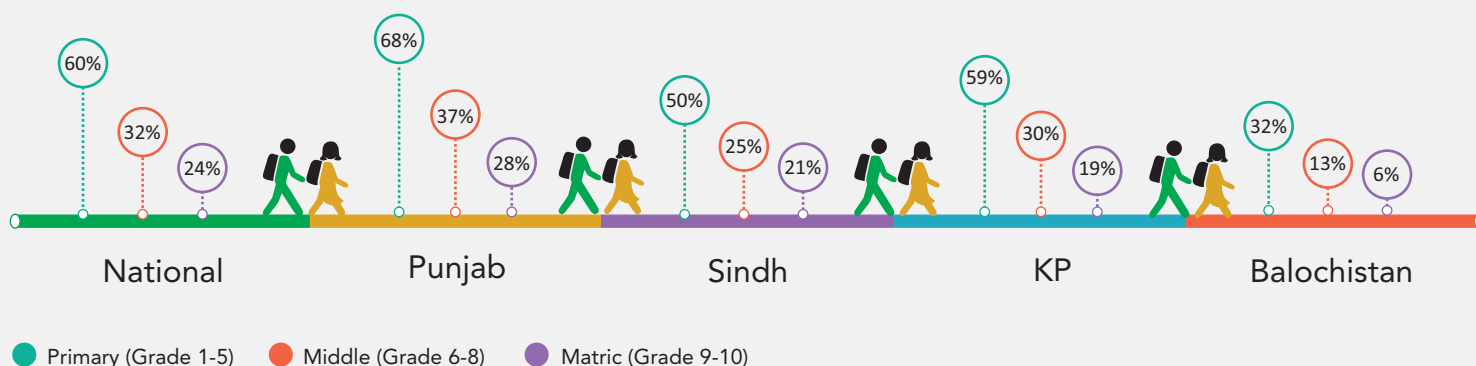


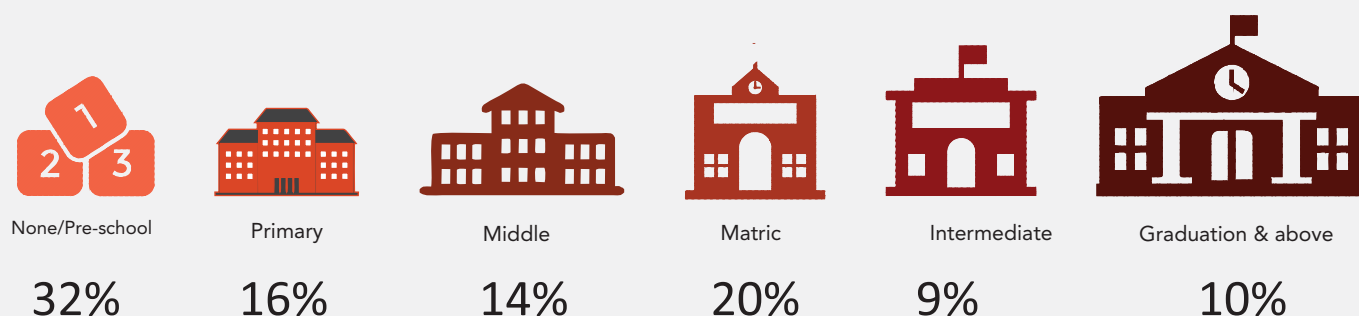

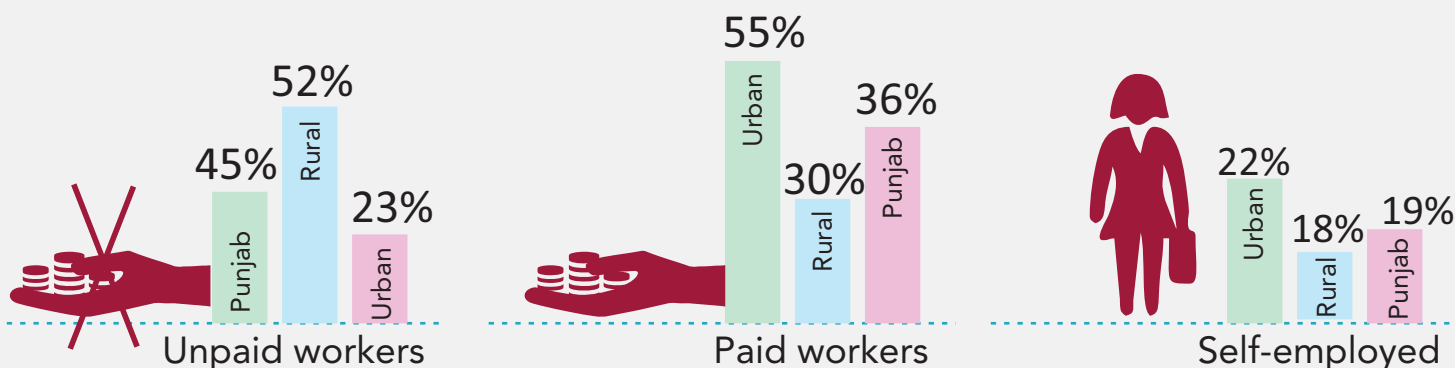
• Net Enrolment Rate of Girls •



• Distribution by Educational Attainment (%) •



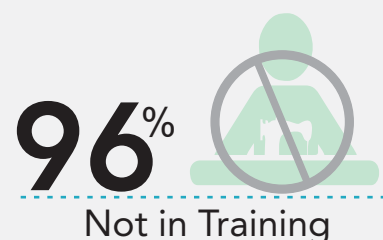
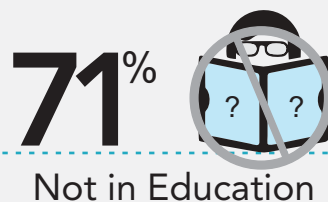
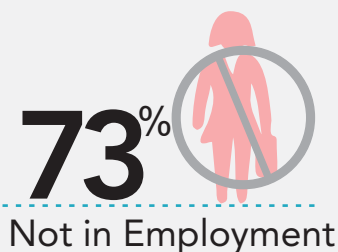
• Type of Employment (%) •



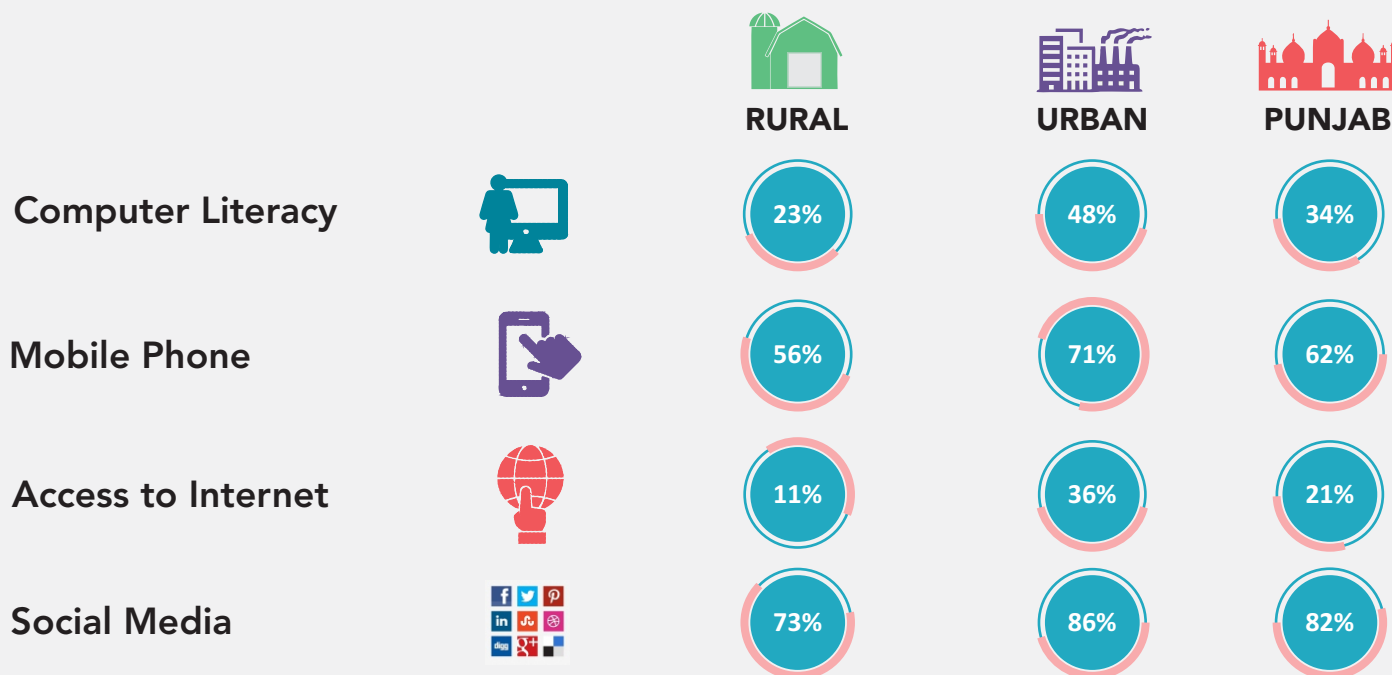
• Young Women (ages 15-24) Not Currently Involved in Education, Employment & Training (%) •
