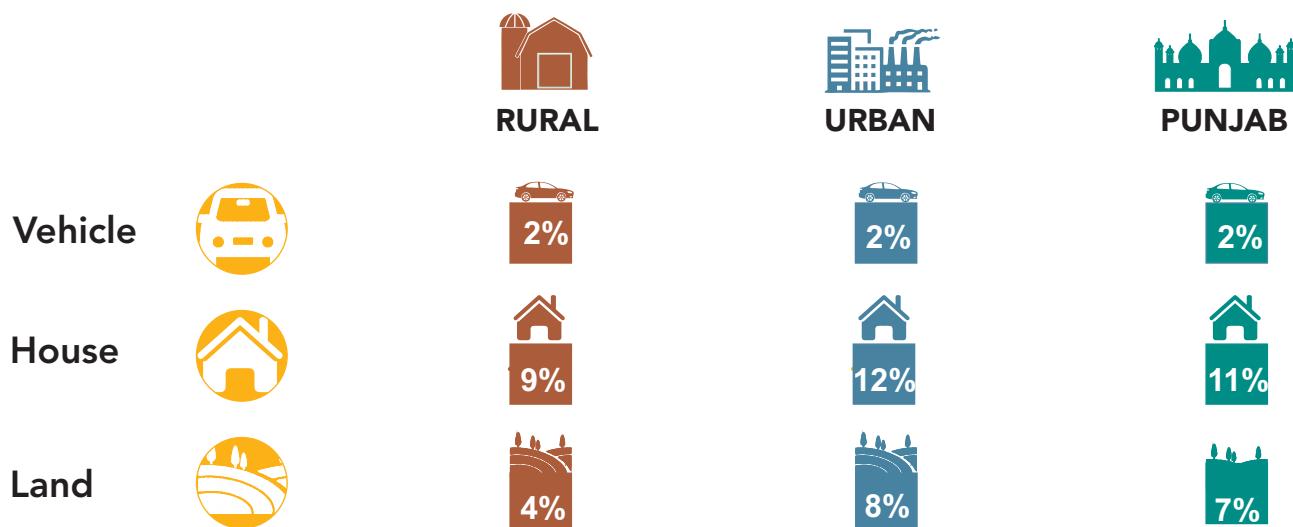




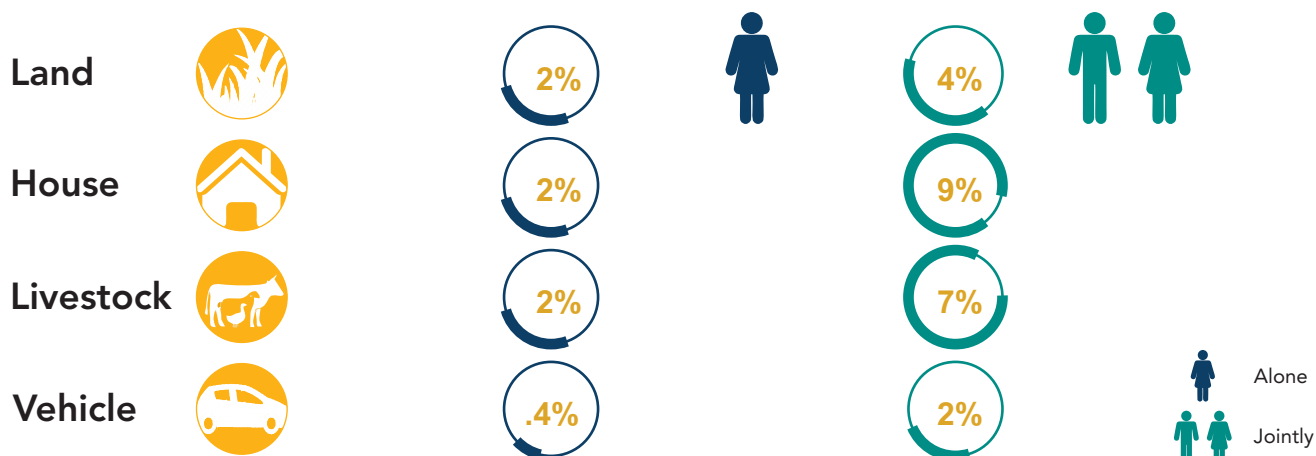

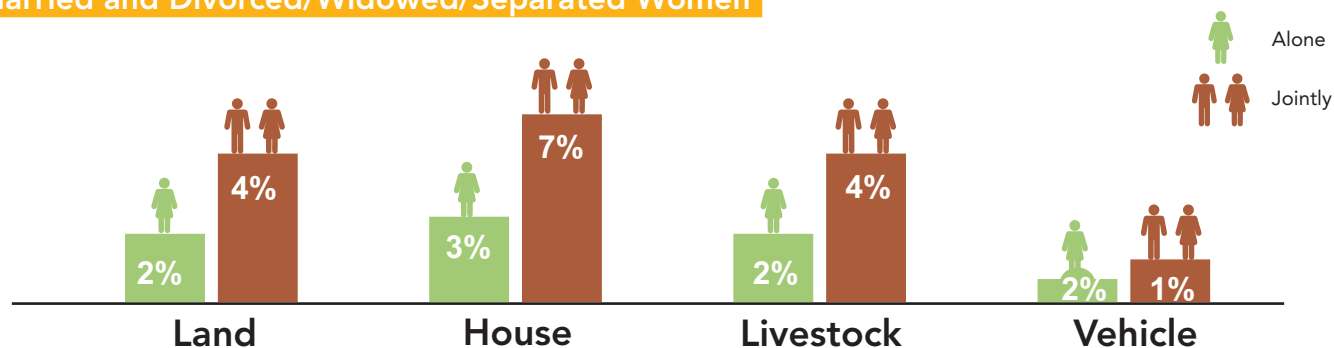

### Currently Married Women

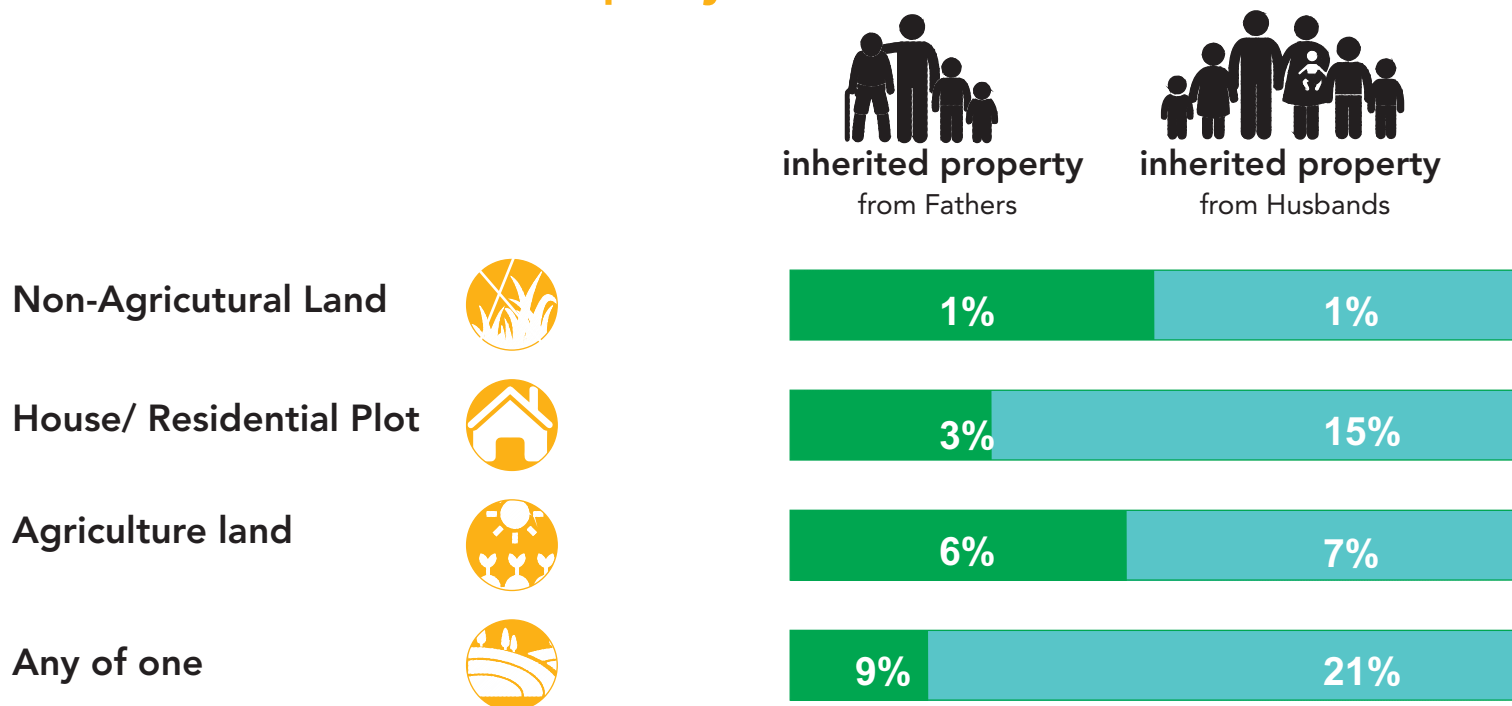


### Never Married and Divorced/Widowed/Separated Women

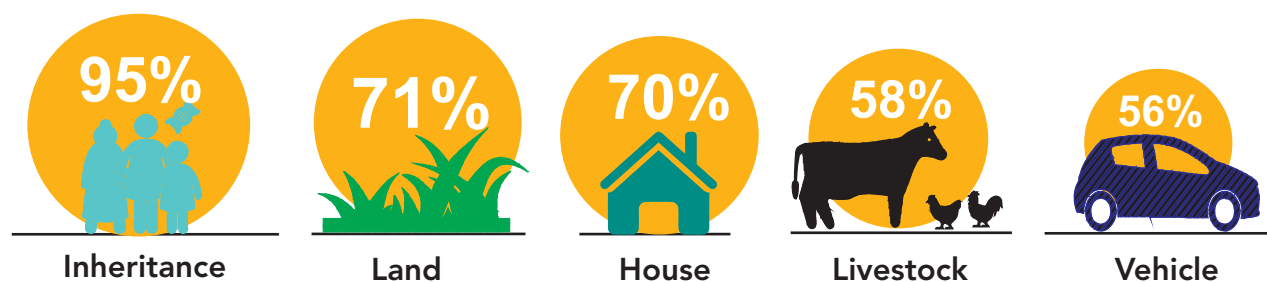
