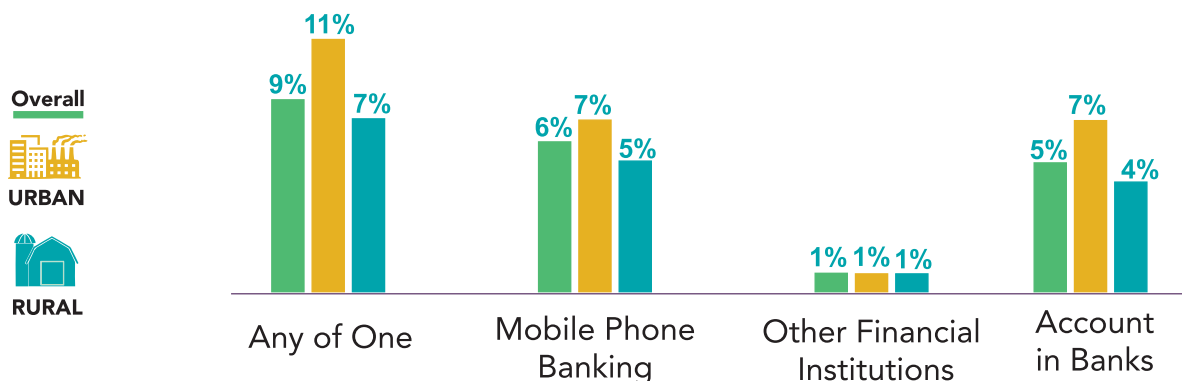


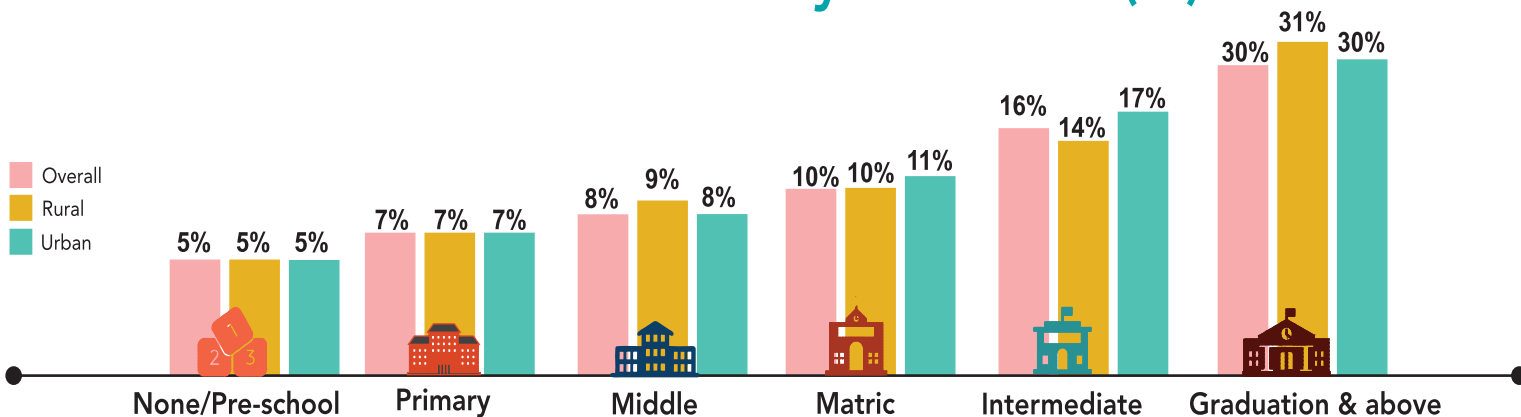

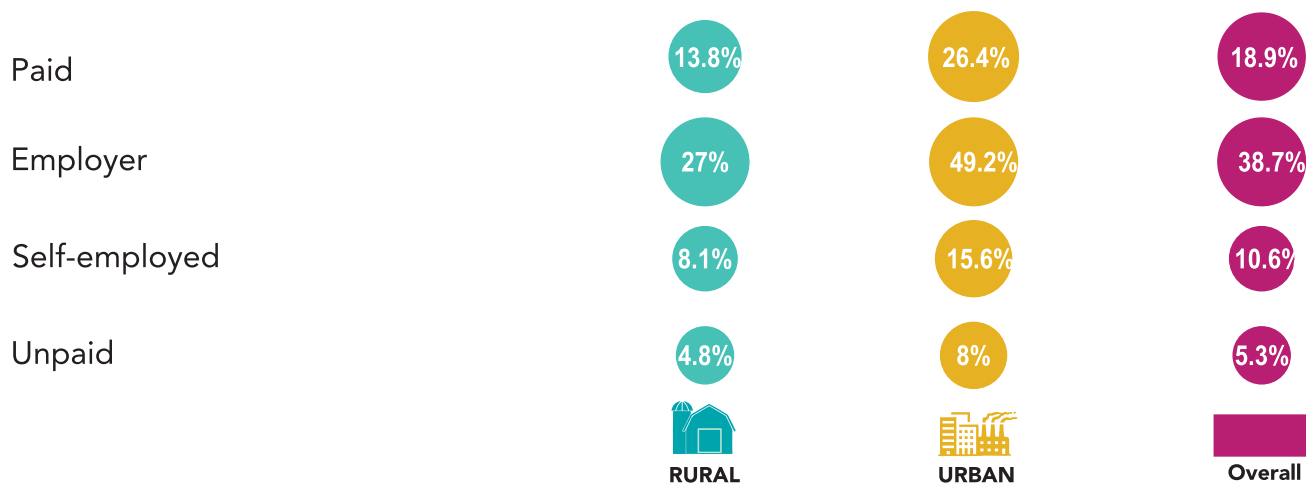
• Women's Use of Financial Services (%) •



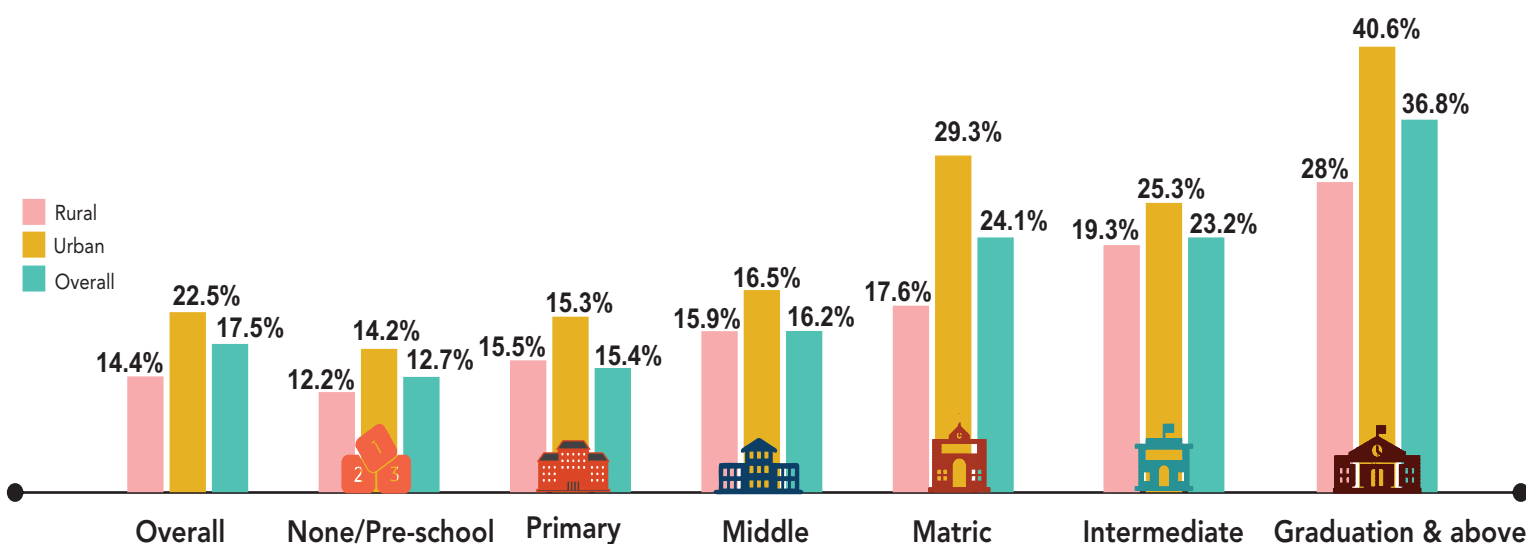
• Women's Financial Inclusion by Education (%) •
